APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

-Brush, roller or spray gun. - Pneumatic equipment.

- Stir the recipient contents thoroughly until evenly mixed.

- Apply on clean, dry and consolidated surfaces. On previously painted surfaces, if the existing paint is gloss, satin, or elastic, tensions may occur resulting in cracks or fissures.

- As with other water-based paints, do not apply in temperatures below 5°C or overly heated surfaces.

PREPARATION

For all types of substrate:

In case of mould, fungal, algae or other parasite contaminations, take the following steps:

- Wash with 10% bleach and water solution.
- Rinse with water.
- Allow to dry thoroughly before painting.
- Prime with Junosan Base Cleaner.
- Use ANTI-MOULD products.

If saline efflorescence (saltpetre) is found:

- Brush and wash with 10% Hydrochloric Acid or 10% Zinc Sulphate solution.
- Rinse with water.
- Allow to dry thoroughly before painting.

APPLICATION RECOMMENDATIONS

Surfaces must be clean of dust, grease, oils, dirt, rust, waste or anything else that may contaminate the paint. Remove the paint, varnishes or old treatments in a poor state and if needed clean up the imperfection, area and exposition with an adequate filler. Shake the container before application to homogenize the paint and the color. Respect the recommended application temperature and the drying times between coats (20°c, relative humidity 65%). The thickness of application, temperature and humidity may affect drying times. Buy only the necessary quantity required, taking into account the m², porosity and support texture. Store the remaining product in a dry and well-ventilated place. Work with the appropriate ventilation and respect the safety precautions norms indicated in the safety data sheet of the product.

CLEANING

Clean the splash and stains immediately with soap water or with an adequate solvent. Clean tools after use (brushes, rollers, pencils, machines etc.) and let them dry before storing.
